

2015 Virginia Annual Conference Consent Agenda

Conference Standing Rule II.E states that the Consent Agenda is to include “agenda items and reports not requiring action by the Annual Conference other than a vote to receive said items for publication in the *Journal*. . . . An individual item may be removed from the Consent Agenda at the request of no less than 30 members of the annual conference. The process for making that request will be determined by the Consent Agenda Committee, and the deadline for such requests will not be prior to ten minutes after the call to order of the annual conference session.”

The Consent Agenda Committee has determined that the deadline for requests of items to be removed from the Consent Agenda is 3:30 p.m. Friday, June 19. Motion forms to request removal of items from the Consent Agenda, at the front of the stage, must be returned to the “secretarial inbox” at the corner of the stage by the established deadline.
