Job Description	The Assistant Youth Ministry Director assists the Director of Ministries with Young People (MYP) in implementing the Director’s vision for Youth Ministry by coordinating one ministry program and supporting the development, implementation and coordination of the remaining ministry programs.
Responsibilities	<p>Include but are not limited to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Prepares and leads (or coordinates) a weekly Bible study using curriculum approved by the MYP Director ● Assist with leading Bible study and small group discussions at Sunday Night Life (SNL) ● Support the MYP Director and Youth Leadership Team in implementing youth discipleship, fellowship, service and stewardship programs ● Assist with organizing and managing Youth Week, the annual summer youth program. This includes attending and supporting Youth Week ● Attend monthly District Youth Council and Youth Leadership Team meetings ● Maintain and update records in the Youth Ministry database as necessary, including family and volunteer information ● Assist with maintaining Youth Ministry communication channels, including bulletin boards, electronic newsletters, and social media ● Present a positive image of New Creation to members of the community and the ministry
Knowledge, Skills and Abilities	Knowledge of biblical and doctrinal principles expressed through the United Methodist Church, excellent written and verbal communication, excellent time management, excellent collaboration skills, ability to provide spiritual guidance and impart biblical knowledge to youth, ability to provide counseling and mentoring to youth, ability to lead or assist leading Bible studies or small group discussions
Preferred Knowledge, Skills and Abilities	Knowledge of social media platforms and ability to know what will engage the ministry’s key target audiences on each platform
Education or Training	Associate’s Degree or equivalent experience, must have strong interpersonal skills along with a strong Christian faith and dedication to living a life worthy of Christ
Level or Type of Experience	At least one year of coordinating any ministry program, preferably related to Youth Ministry
Conditions of Employment	Bi-weekly one-on-one meetings with the MYP Director (and/or Senior Pastor, as needed), actively attend worship services and activities at New Creation.
Hours Required	~12 hours per week (~624 hours per year), increased hours during retreats
Annual Salary/Hourly Rate	Commensurate with education and experience
